- Judging from 11.00am.
- Public admission from 2.00pm.
- Presentation of trophies at 3.30pm followed by the auction of exhibits.
- No exhibit to be removed before 4.00pm.
- Three points awarded for first place, two for second and one for third.
- All trophies must be left for engraving.
